About the Program

Orange Grove Center is a private, non-profit organization serving adults and children with intellectual disabilities. Orange Grove was established in 1953 by families of children in Hamilton County, TN, who desperately needed educational services.

Orange Grove serves approximately 1000 individuals and employs approximately 800 professional staff members to provide a wide array of community services.

Services include educational, vocational and employment opportunities, residential options, services for Georgia residents, and enrichment, therapy and health care (medical and dental) services.

Speech - Language Pathology provides services in the areas of:

- Evaluation of speech, language, swallowing and cognitive-communication functioning
- Individual and group therapy to improve cognition, communication and swallowing disorders
- Assessments for augmentative and alternative communication (AAC) methods and devices
- Coordinated care with other health care professionals, including primary care providers, audiologists, occupational therapists and physical therapists
- Training and support for families, caregivers, and staff who provide patient care
